# Greetings in the name of the Living Christ,

Beginning August 2<sup>nd</sup>, we resume Sunday Morning Worship in the sanctuary! This return to sanctuary, however, will not be a return to "normal" as we formerly knew it. We must continue to assure all who enter that our sacred space is also a sanitary and safe space. We will need greeters to help with extending hospitality at all three entrances to our worship space. Please volunteer.

Upon entry, all must wear masks register their attendance and sanitize their hands. Pews will be marked to insure safe distance seating, so once the service begins all will be invited to remove their masks if that is more comfortable. Hymnals and bulletins will be picked up from stations at each entrance, and we suggest worshippers bring their own Bibles (all pew racks will be emptied for now).

Communion cups and wafers will also be picked up on entry, to be consumed at the proper time, together and in place. The offering plates will not be passed, but placed at each exit point for your convenience.

We don't want to lose that. For a while, though, we will not be able to have a choir gathered in the choir loft. We will try to offer a variety of special music, both instrumental and vocal, by soloists, duets, trios, and even quartets. <u>Please volunteer</u>.

Knowing many of our beloved members will not be ready to return to public worship just yet, we will continue to live stream worship in real time on Facebook, and repost a video recording of it on the website soon after. We also continue to share audio recordings of special music and sermon via local radio. We want to include all we can.
